

Portage Center for the Arts BIG Summer Sweepstakes Official Rules

OFFICIAL RULES

1. **ELIGIBILITY: NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR CLAIM PRIZE.** Making a donation to Portage Center for the Arts (PCA) will not improve your chances of winning. Sweepstakes is void where otherwise restricted or prohibited by law. To enter Portage Center for the Arts BIG Summer Sweepstakes (the "Sweepstakes"), you: (i) must be a citizen of the United States or a lawful permanent resident of the United States; (ii) must be 18 years of age or older at the time of entering the Sweepstakes; and (iii) must not be considered a minor in your state of residence.

2. **TO ENTER SWEEPSTAKES:** Sweepstakes begins on or about May 15, 2024. To enter, complete the official Sweepstakes entry form(s) and mail, no later than July 31, 2024, to: Portage Center for the Arts, PO Box 866, Portage WI 53901. All entries must be post-marked on or before July 31, 2024.

One (1) Third Prize: gift certificate for season tickets to PCA's Concert Series. Retail value: \$120.00. Cannot be redeemed for cash.

4. **DRAWINGS:** All prize winners will be selected from all eligible entry forms received via a random drawing held on or about August 2, 2024. Selected winners will be notified by PCA via telephone, mail or the email address supplied during entry at PCA's sole discretion. The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received. PCA's decisions are based on its sole discretion and interpretation of these official rules, and are final and binding in all respects. If a potential winner does not respond to the prize notification within ten (10) business days from the first notification attempt, then such entrant will be disqualified and an alternate winner will be selected. If said alternate winner does not respond, the prize category will be considered void.

5. **GENERAL:** By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of PCA, which shall be final and binding in all respects and in all matters relating to this promotion. If documents are not returned in a timely manner, are returned as non-deliverable, or if winner is found to be ineligible or not in compliance with these Official Rules, winner will be disqualified. All taxes on

PCA may prohibit an entrant from participating in the Sweepstakes or winning a prize if, in its sole discretion, it determines that said entrant is attempting to undermine the legitimate operation of the Sweepstakes by cheating, deception, or other unfair practices or intending to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other entrants, PCA, or Sweepstakes Entities. PCA, its advertising and promotion agencies and all of their respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, agencies, agents and representatives and their respective employees, officers and directors are not responsible and shall not be liable for: (a) any human error which may occur in the processing of entries; (b) lost, late, or misdirected entries; or (c) any condition caused by events that may cause the promotion to be disrupted or corrupted.
