## Registration

Due to limited roles in the script, if we experience a high level of interested students, we may not be able to cast every person. There are a total of 21 roles that we can offer students in grades 3-5. Therefore, we will be able to have 21 actors involved in this production. If your student is interested in working on a crew, those positions are exempt from the limit.

Acting roles will be secured through registration on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration will take place August 30th-September 6th. To register, you must complete the necessary paperwork and turn in the workshop fee. (If several applicants register at the same time and limited spots are available, preference may be given to current ZGYPT students.)

To sort participants into acting roles, we ask questions within our registration paperwork. Candid answers are appreciated, as they will help us decipher which role will help each actor shine on stage. In every new learning experience, there is always a learning curve. However, we wish to avoid any unnecessary stress on students, parents, and staff by attempting to avoid placing students in roles where they would be completely overwhelmed, unprepared, or uncomfortable.

Please note that guardians/parents must be active participants at home, assisting and encouraging their children to practice their roles between workshop dates. The bulk of line memorization will need to happen between workshop sessions. We will email workshop video clips to guardians/parents so that students can easily review their parts and solidify lines.
